Pillows, blankets and bedding will be provided to all members of the encampment. Please do not bring a pillow, blanket, sheets or sleeping bag. Wool Blankets are provided. If you have a wool allergy, please notify the Encampment Staff and bring a conservative, solid-color blanket.

## Idaho Wing Encampment Contraband Policy

Our goal is to have a safe event with no incidents. This policy is to provide a safe environment for all cadets and staff. Most accidents or incidents occur due to negligence and some items listed are contraband because they create distractions for yourself or others.

The following not all-inclusive list is contraband:

- Food of any kind (i.e. Snacks, Candy, Drinks, etc.) (Travel food is appropriate)
- “Sharps” of any kind (i.e. knives, scissors, box cutters, Leatherman, hobby knife, straight blade razors, etc.)  
Exception: the tiny 1” scissors common in sewing kits)
- Glass of any kind (i.e. glass jars or bottles)
- Flame producing devices (i.e. lighters, matches, lighter fuel, or flares)
- Fireworks, model rocket engines, and other explosive devices
- Aerosol cans and inhalants (i.e. spray deodorant, spray starch, paints, whipping cream in a can, etc) hairspray and shaving cream excluded
- Pornographic, or sexually suggestive material
- Cameras (Film, electronic)
- Sound systems (including but not limited to CD players and MP3 players, portable TVs or DVD players, gaming systems, computers, bluetooth speakers)
- Musical instruments
- Smartwatches or Fitbits (i.e any wrist devices that has bluetooth)
- Performance enhancing supplements (i.e. Caffeine pills, Rip Fuel, Creatine, Hydroxycut, etc.)
- Tobacco of any kind (i.e. cigarettes, cigars, pipes, snuff, chew, vapes/e-cigs, etc.)
- Illegal drugs, narcotics, and medications not prescribed to an individual
- Guns or ammunition of any kind (even if you are a senior member and have a permit to carry a concealed weapon)
- Archery equipment
- Any non CAP approved radios.
- Anything that violates CAP Regulations (i.e. nondiscrimination policy)
- Any item that a Senior Officer deems a safety hazard to yourself or others around you.
- Expensive jewelry, or valuables that may be lost
- Make-up, or similar cosmetics
- Liquid boot polish
- Any adhesive tape (Duct tape, masking tape, etc.)

During in-processing, all items brought with you will be searched and any item found will be confiscated and held till the end of the activity. This includes cell phones and POV keys if a cadet drives themselves. Bring phones for arriving to and departing from encampment. Cadet cell phones will be turned in during in-processing. Bring your cell phone charger. Anyone found in possession of these items after the initial in-processing is subject to disciplinary action, up to and including removal from the event.
